Requires procurement officers to consider past performance when making a determination of offeror responsibility. Appropriates funds. (HB1146 HD1)	GVO, WAM

<u>HB 889, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1113)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS. Establishes the Office of Public-Private Partnership and the position of Public-Private Partnership Coordinator. Adds public-private partnership project delivery methods and related conditions and requirements to the Hawaii Public Procurement Code. Requires an annual report. Appropriates funds. (HB889 HD1)	GVO, WAM
