private entities.

member in the Sovereign States Drug Consortium to lower medicaid

purchasing and administrative costs to the State.

Status

Creates the intellectual and developmental disabilities medicaid waiver administrative claiming special fund into which federal moneys may be deposited from DOH's participation in waiver program established per SSA §1915(c). Establishes task force to examine existing §1915(c)

# RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

HLT/HSH, FIN

Authorizes the Department of Humans Services and the Department of Health to contract the services of dedicated capture managers responsible for securing grant and other funding opportunities for each department. Appropriates funds.

#### DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
