HB 1157
Status

RELATING TO POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION STUDENT HLT/LHE, FIN
IMMUNIZATIONS.
Temporarily exempts students in post-secondary education programs
from immunization requirements if they attend classes exclusively
online or through distance learning.

HB 902
Status

RELATING TO LOAN REPAYMENT FOR HEALTH CARE HLT/LHE, FIN
PROFESSIONALS.
Appropriates funds for the health care provider loan repayment
program administered through the John A. Burns School of Medicine
of the University of Hawaii at Manoa; provided that the funds are
matched on a dollar-for-dollar basis by a private or another public
source.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Testimony should indicate:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee(s) to which the comments are directed;
- The date and time of the hearing; and



- Measure number.

While every effort will be made to incorporate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:

PAPER: 20 copies (including an original) to Room 403 in the State Capitol;

FAX: For testimony less than 5 pages in length, transmit to 808-586-6311 (Oahu) or 1-800-535-3859 (for Neighbor Islander without a computer to submit testimony through the website); or


WEB: For testimony less than 20MB in size, transmit from <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/submittestimony.aspx>.

Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
