Requires the Department of Human Services to submit a report to the Legislature prior to the 2020 Regular Session. Appropriates funds. (HB713 HD1)	HMS, WAM
HB 1355, HD2 (HSCR1230) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE STATE COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN. Appropriates funds for operational expenses of the State Commission on the Status of Women. (HB1355 HD2)	HMS, WAM
HB 1417, HD1 (HSCR1208) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES. Requires the Department of Human Services to use an integrated and multigenerational approach to delivering human services to reduce the incidence of intergenerational poverty and dependence on public benefits. (HB1417 HD1)	HMS, WAM
HB 1554, HD2 (HSCR1262) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES OPERATING BUDGET. Relates to the Department of Human Services operating budget. (HB1554 HD2)	HMS, WAM
