<u>HB 1533</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION. Establishes a historic preservation tax credit for qualified construction expenses incurred in rehabilitation of historic structures that produces affordable housing units.	HSG, FIN
<u>HB 1204</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HOUSING. Appropriates funds into and out of the rental housing revolving fund for the purposes for which the fund was established, such as providing loans or grants for the development, pre-development, construction, acquisition, preservation, and substantial rehabilitation of rental housing units.	HSG, FIN
<u>HB 1312</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HOUSING. Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds to be appropriated into and out of the rental housing revolving fund.	HSG, FIN
