The following measure(s) has been **ADDED** to the agenda: **HB1012**

<u>HB 40</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES. Authorizes health care providers, non-profit organizations, businesses, and faith-based organizations to distribute supplemental nutrition assistance program applications to prospective applicants. Requires any organization distributing supplemental nutrition assistance program applications to maintain records of the distribution that shall be made available to the Department of Human Services upon request. <u>HB 1014</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO MEDICAID WAIVER. Removes sunset date of section 321-14.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and adds exception for Medicaid waiver provider-agencies providing services to Medicaid waiver participants.	HSH, FIN
<u>HB 1012</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ESTABLISHING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE ON AGING ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIMING SPECIAL FUND. Creates the Executive Office on Aging Administrative Claiming Special Fund to enhance the drawdown of federal funds.	HSH, FIN

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:


PAPER: Eight (8) copies (including an original) to Room 314 in the State Capitol;
