<u>SB 3</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO GUARDIANSHIP. Requires the court to appoint an attorney to represent the respondent in a guardianship petition. Requires the court appointed attorney to meet with the respondent at least once prior to the guardianship petition hearing.	JDC, WAM
<u>SB 4</u> Status & Testimony	PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION TO AMEND THE QUALIFYING AGE OF VOTERS FOR ANY STATE OR LOCAL ELECTION. Proposes a constitutional amendment to lower the qualifying age of voters for any state or local election to sixteen years of age.	JDC, WAM
<u>SB 97</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO ELECTIONS. Requires the office of elections to join the Electronic Registration Information Center and share information with counties to encourage voter participation and ensure integrity of voter registration rolls. Appropriates moneys.	JDC, WAM
<u>SB 105</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO JURY DUTY. Clarifies that jurors are entitled to reimbursement for reasonable transportation costs to and from the court. Includes rail fare, bicycle rental, or taxi costs or other hired car service up to a specified maximum amount.	JDC, WAM
<u>SB 130</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CIVIL LEGAL SERVICES. Appropriates funds for the judiciary to purchase civil legal services for low and moderate income persons.	JDC, WAM

<u>SB 206</u>	RELATED TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE.	JDC, WAM
<u>Status & Testimony</u>	Increases the amount of fines that may be assessed against a noncandidate committee for violations of organizational report requirements. Increases the amount of fines that may be assessed for violations of advertisement requirements.	
<u>SB 288</u>	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.	JDC, WAM
<u>Status & Testimony</u>	Appropriates funds for the Department of the Attorney General. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/2050.	
<u>SB 424</u>	RELATING TO CRIMINAL RECORDS.	JDC, WAM
<u>Status & Testimony</u>	Establishes the Uniform Criminal Records Accuracy Act in the State.	
<u>SB 852</u>	RELATING TO RESTITUTION FOR VICTIMS OF CRIME.	JDC, WAM
<u>Status & Testimony</u>	Clarifies that reimbursement to crime victims includes lost wages, mental health treatment, and therapy.
