Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SPEEDY TRIAL. Creates a statutory right of victims and witnesses of sexual offenses under part V of chapter 707, HRS, to a speedy trial in criminal cases involving adult defendants.	JDC, WAM
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO LOBBYISTS. Removes statutory remnants from when violations of the lobbyist law resulted in criminal penalties. Allows the state ethics commission to assess an administrative fine pursuant to a settlement agreement.	JDC, WAM
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO DISTRICT COURT JUDGES. Establishes one additional district court judgeship in the First Circuit and in the Second Circuit.	JDC, WAM
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO BAIL. Authorizes a defendant in custody to petition a court for unsecured bail.	JDC, WAM
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO ARRANGEMENT OF CANDIDATE NAMES ON BALLOTS. Requires candidate names to be randomized on individual ballots and randomly rotated across precincts.	JDC, WAM

Status & Testimony	RELATED TO JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS. Makes permanent the requirement that decisions in contested case hearings of the Commission on Water Resource Management, Land Use Commission, Public Utilities Commission, Hawaii Community Development Authority, and those involving conservation districts be appealed directly to the Supreme Court, with certain exceptions. Effective 6/30/19.	JDC, WAM
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TAXATION. Creates a nexus standard for taxing out-of-state businesses on their business income in Hawaii.	JDC, WAM
SB 635 Status & Testimony	PROPOSING AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE IX, SECTION 5, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF HAWAII. Proposes an amendment to article IX, section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii, to require the State to assure that each resident of the State has access to housing, subject to standards and criteria to be provided by the legislature. Status & Testimony	RELATING TO GENDER EQUITY. Requires all places of public accommodation constructed or substantially modified after June 30, 2019, to provide baby diaper-changing accommodations that are equally accessible to men and women.	JDC, CPH/WAM
