HB 756, HD1 RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. TRS, JDC

(SSCR1320)

Status & Testimony

Requires the DOT, after consultation with the counties, to adopt rules prescribing uniform standards and specifications for all official traffic control devices placed pursuant to the Statewide Traffic Code. Specifies the factors the DOT and the counties must take into account when setting maximum speed limits on a

road. (HB756 HD1)

HB 1009, HD1, SD1 RELATING TO MOVIE THEATERS. CPH, JDC

(SSCR1424)

Status & Testimony

Requires a movie theater to provide at least two showings per week per movie offered with open movie captioning. Removes the option for a movie theater to provide eyewear to fulfill the open movie captioning requirement. Makes the open captioning requirement permanent by repealing the sunset date of Act 39,

Session Laws of Hawaii 2015. (SD1)

HB 1053, HD1 RELATING TO STATE IDENTIFICATION CARDS. TRS, JDC

(SSCR1323) Amends the mandatory inscription for civil identification cards to conform with the inscription currently in use. (HB1053 HD1)

HB 1165, HD2, SD1 RELATING TO GENDER IDENTIFICATION. TRS, JDC Requires a license or state identification card to include a (SSCR1324) person's full legal name, date of birth, gender designation, residence address, and license number. Specifies gender Status & designation options of F, M, or X. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1) **Testimony** HB 1217, HD1 RELATING TO VOTER REGISTRATION. TRS, JDC Makes inclusion of an affidavit application for voter registration [Measure deleted (SSCR1325) mandatory for all driver's license and identification card on 04-01-19] applications. Automatically registers each applicant who elects Status & to register for voting. Requires sharing of information among the **Testimony** counties, DOT, and election personnel. (HB1217 HD1) ENCOURAGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND SCR 74 / SR 52 EDU, JDC OTHER AGENCY AND COMMUNITY STAKEHOLDERS TO (SSCR1624) / CONTINUE MEETING AS A WORKING GROUP FOR SEXUAL (SSCR1625) VIOLENCE PREVENTION EDUCATION IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
