Extends the safe harbor provisions found in section 45 of Act 181, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, until 7/1/20 to provide sufficient time for condominium property regimes to update their developer's public reports. Clarifies that the sale of time share plans are permitted

regardless of compliance with Act 181. (SB552 HD1)
