facility. (SB1232 HD1)

RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL

LICENSING.

Requires the Board of Dentistry to adopt rules for the regulation of dental assistants using certification options based on education level and permitted duties. Requires the Board to report to the Legislature

on the progress of any rules adopted. (SB774 HD2)
