SB 1046, SD2 (SSCR1016) Status	RELATING TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. Allows an employee to take family leave in addition to victim leave when the leave is related to domestic or sexual violence against the employee or the employee's minor child. Requires an employee to submit certification related to domestic or sexual violence of the employee or the employee's minor child. SB 785, SD1 (SSCR1074) Status	RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING. Allows the scope of collective bargaining negotiations to include benefits. SB 1048, SD1 (SSCR993) Status	RELATING TO SEXUAL HARASSMENT. Makes unenforceable confidentiality clauses in employment contracts when an act of sexual harassment is claimed by an employee. Bans mandatory arbitration agreements as to sexual harassment claims	LAB, JUD, FIN

beginning July 1, 2019. Makes mandatory confidentiality clauses in an arbitration agreement unenforceable as to sexual harassment claims.
