RELATING TO STANDARDIZED TESTING.

LHE/LAB, FIN

Status

Limits public school students' participation in standardized tests and provides notice to students and parents or guardians of the opportunity to opt out of standardized tests. Prohibits use of standardized test scores for the evaluation of teachers and educational officers.

HB 919

RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING.

LHE/LAB, FIN

Status

Establishes a collective bargaining unit for graduate student assistants

employed by the University of Hawaii.
