SB 182 RELATING TO COUNTY AUTHORITY ON THE SALE OF

TOBACCO PRODUCTS.

Status & Allows counties to adopt and enforce additional ordinances that require the sale or use of cigarettes, tobacco products, and

regulate the sale or use of cigarettes, tobacco products, and electronic smoking devices. Requires county ordinances to be no less protective of public health than state law. Repeals statute that preempts local smoking ordinances and regulations and voids any local law or regulation that conflicts with state

smoking laws.
