SB 557 RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT. PSM/JDC, WAM

Status & Testimony

Prohibits state and county law enforcement agencies from complying with federal immigration detainers or honoring requests for non-public information unless specifically required to do so by a warrant signed by a judge or provisions of federal,

state, or local law.

SB 1422 RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT. PSM/JDC

Status & Testimony

Specifies that law enforcement officers have the discretion to issue citations, in lieu of making an arrest, for non-violent class C felonies, misdemeanors, petty misdemeanors, and violations.

SB 1423 RELATING TO PAYMENT OF BAIL. PSM/JDC

Status & Permits defendants for whom a monetary amount of bail has been set to pay the bail amount on a twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week basis and be released from custody

forthwith upon posting or payment of bail.
