<u>HB 213, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR944)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PRIVATE PROPERTY. Authorizes a property owner or agent to enter vacant adjacent property under certain conditions to control albizia trees before they become hazardous. Provides defense to criminal prosecution. (HB213 HD1)	PSM, JDC
<u>HB 1305, HD2</u> <u>(HSCR1195)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT. Authorizes the State and electrical and gas utilities to enter into a mutual assistance agreement with an out-of-state utility to assist in the restoration of electrical or natural gas power following a natural disaster or emergency. (HB1305 HD2)	PSM, CPH
<u>HB 878, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR884)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM JURY DUTY. Exempts from jury duty any active member of the Hawaii emergency management agency or a county emergency management agency. (HB878 HD1)	PSM, JDC
<u>HB 329, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1205)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO DISASTER RELIEF. Amends the Kauai flooding disaster relief appropriation made in Act 12, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, to include flood mitigation measures. Extends the lapse date of the appropriation to June 30, 2020. Exempts the appropriation from certain restrictions on transfers of or changes to appropriations. (HB329 HD1)	PSM, WAM
<u>HB 1180, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR904)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO NATURAL DISASTERS. Appropriates funds for disaster relief, recovery, mitigation, and remediation activities for the County of Hawaii. Requires reporting of monthly expenditures to the Department of Budget and Finance. (HB1180 HD1)	PSM, WAM
<u>HB 993, HD2</u> <u>(HSCR1257)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT. To improve and enhance the effectiveness of the State Emergency Management Program through modifications and additions to the Hawaii Revised Statute Chapter 127A. (HB993 HD2)	PSM, WAM

<p><u>HB 1334, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1023)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u></p>	<p>RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OPERATING BUDGET. Relates to the Department of Defense budget.</p>	<p>PSM, WAM Removed 3/13/19</p>
<p><u>HB 990, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1256)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u></p>	<p>RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE FACILITIES. Allows the Department of Defense to recoup operating costs when the Adjutant General permits temporary facility use of department facilities to the public and requires remaining net proceeds to be deposited into the general fund. (HB990 HD1)</p>	<p>PSM, WAM</p>
<p><u>HB 991, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR886)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u></p>	<p>RELATING TO STATE MILITARY FORCES. Applies the protections of civil relief for state military forces to persons serving on full time National Guard duty under title 32 United States Code and to bring provisions in line with the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act, codified in 50 United States Code chapter 50 (§§3901-4043). (HB991 HD1)</p>	<p>PSM, WAM Removed 3/13/19</p>
<p><u>HB 1553, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR907)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u></p>	<p>RELATING TO HOMELAND SECURITY. Establishes the Hawaii State Fusion Center as a program under the Office of Homeland Security and establishes the position of Hawaii State Fusion Center Director who shall be state-funded, responsible to the Director of Homeland Security, and accountable to manage the operations of the Center. Effective 1/28/2081. (HB1553 HD1)</p>	<p>PSM, WAM Removed 3/11/19</p>
