Status

RELATING TO VEHICLE REGISTRATION.  
Increases the number of vehicles owned by disabled veterans that are exempt from state registration fees to two vehicles.

RELATING TO CAR REGISTRATION FEE EXEMPTION FOR  
DISABLED VETERANS.  
Repeals requirement that a disabled veteran be in receipt of disability retirement pay in order to be exempt from the payment of annual vehicle registration fees.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


