<b><u>SB 164</u></b> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO UNADJUDICATED TRAFFIC FINES. Transfers certain fines and forfeitures collected for uncontested traffic infractions to the counties.	TRS/PSM, JDC/WAM
<b><u>SB 658</u></b> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. Requires motor vehicles to have headlights and taillights on at all times during the operation of the vehicle.	TRS/PSM, CPH
<b><u>SB 1276</u></b> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO MOTOR CARRIER VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTIONS. Expands authority of the Director of Transportation over required motor carrier vehicle inspections.	TRS/PSM, WAM
<b><u>SB 1505</u></b> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO HARBORS. Authorizes the department of transportation to make harbor facilities temporarily available as a harbor of safe refuge when the National Weather Service forecasts a tropical storm or hurricane strength cyclones, unless specifically prohibited by the United States Coast Guard Captain of the Port.	TRS/PSM
<b><u>SB 603</u></b> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO THE VEHICLE WEIGHT TAX EXEMPTION FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL. Repeals the requirement that a member of the National Guard, military reserve, or armed forces must be assigned to a unit in the State in order to qualify for a vehicle weight tax exemption. Clarifies that the vehicle weight tax exemption is available to service members who claim Hawaii as their residence of record.	PSM/TRS, WAM
