HB 327, HD1 RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. TRS, WAM Directs the Department of Transportation to develop and (HSCR829) implement a single occupant vehicle access fee to use a zipper lane on Oahu. Requires that revenues generated from the Status & single occupant vehicle access fee be deposited in the state **Testimony** highway fund. (HB327 HD1) HB 421, HD2 RELATING TO THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX. TRS, JDC HB 754, HD1 Establishes a framework for the Department of Transportation (HSCR1007) and the counties to regulate electric foot scooters. Adds definition of electric foot scooter. Amends definitions of moped, Status & motor vehicle, rental motor vehicle, and vehicle to exclude **Testimony** electric foot scooters. Prohibits use of electric foot scooters to individuals under the age of eighteen. (HB754 HD1) RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION. HB 755, HD1 TRS, WAM Appropriates funds for the fiscal biennium 2019-2021 operating [Measure deleted (HSCR1035) budget of the Department of Transportation. (HB755 HD1) on 03/12/19] Status & **Testimony** HB 756, HD1 RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. TRS, JDC Requires the DOT, after consultation with the counties, to adopt (HSCR1008) rules prescribing uniform standards and specifications for all official traffic control devices placed pursuant to the Statewide Status & **Testimony** Traffic Code. Specifies the factors the DOT and the counties must take into account when setting maximum speed limits on a road. (HB756 HD1) HB 839, HD1 RELATING TO TRAFFIC SIGNALS ON THE PALI HIGHWAY. TRS, WAM

Appropriates funds for installing signalized crosswalks and

related pedestrian improvements at four specified unsignalized intersections in the Nu'uanu area of the Pali Highway. (HB839)
