HB 114 (HSCR796) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AMENDING OR REPEALING HAWAII INCOME TAX LAWS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DELETING OBSOLETE OR UNNECESSARY PROVISIONS. Repeals unnecessary or redundant provisions of the income tax law.	WAM
HB 120 (HSCR797) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO STATE BONDS. Authorizes issuance of general obligation bonds. Makes findings required by Article VII, Section 13, of the State Constitution to declare that the issuance of authorized bonds will not cause the debt limit to be exceeded.	WAM
HB 121 (HSCR798) Status & Testimony	RELATED TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS. Abolishes the Captain Cook memorial fund, custodial services special fund, donations for voter registration drive trust account, and information technology trust fund of the Department of Accounting and General Services and transfers unencumbered balances to the general fund.	WAM
HB 122 (HSCR853) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS. Abolishes the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant Trust Fund of the Department of Defense and transfers the unencumbered balance to the general fund.	WAM
HB 1413, HD1 (HSCR865) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST E OLA MAU NA LEO O KEKAHA. Authorizes the issuance of special purpose revenue bonds (SPRB) to assist E Ola Mau Na Leo O Kekaha with the acquisition, remediation, and development of the old Kekaha Sugar Mill in Kekaha, Kauai, Hawaii. (HB 1413 HD1)	WAM
HB 1190, HD1 (HSCR1163) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TAXATION. Changes income tax rates for taxable years beginning after December 31, 2018. (HB1190 HD1)	WAM

HB 1193 (HSCR810) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TAXATION. Amends the income tax credit for expenses for household and dependent care services necessary for gainful employment by changing the taxpayer's applicable percentage of employment-related expenses that constitutes the tax credit and cap amount. SCR 117 / SR 87 Status & Testimony / Status & Testimony	REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF TAXATION TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE TO CONSIDER WORLDWIDE COMBINED REPORTING OF CORPORATE INCOME.	WAM
