<a href="#">HB425</a>	RELATING TO WATER QUALITY MONITORING. Appropriates funds for an additional full-time Environmental Health Specialist IV position within the Department of Health to monitor water quality on the island of Hawaii.	WLH, FIN
<a href="#">HB773</a>	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM. Establishes the office of creative media industries Hawaii in statute, and provide that the Hawaii film office shall be an agency of that office. Renames the Hawaii Television and Film Development Board as the Creative Industries Hawaii Advisory Group. Renames the Hawaii Television and Film Development Special Fund as the Creative Media and Film Infrastructure Special Fund. Expands funding sources for the Creative Media and Film Infrastructure Special Fund to support creative industries development within the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism. Amends the purposes for which the Creative Media and Film Infrastructure Special Fund may be used. Establishes and appropriates funds for positions. Appropriates funds for operations and programs.
