#### **OVERVIEW**

The mission of the Department of Public Safety (PSD) is to uphold justice and public safety by providing correctional and law enforcement services to Hawaii's communities with professionalism, integrity and fairness.

The Department is able to accomplish this mission through three major Divisions: Corrections, Law Enforcement and General Administration. Our overall goal is to protect people and property from injury and loss caused by criminal actions. PSD programs provide and coordinate specialized services, facilities, security, and legislation to preserve the peace; to prevent and deter crimes; to detect, apprehend, detain, and rehabilitate criminals; and where appropriate, to compensate victims of crime.

We have apprised the Legislature of the myriad of challenges that we face as a Department. We appreciate your understanding and responsiveness, as reflected in the appropriations we have been given. We take this opportunity to describe the most significant challenges and the activities underway.

 <u>Jail Overcrowding</u>: Expansion projects are currently underway at HCCC, KCCC, and MCCC. Although, these expansions will not fully address the overcrowding, they will provide significant relief to existing conditions. We have also started the planning and design for a housing expansion project at WCCC that is expected to add up to 180 beds. Budget Informational Briefing

- <u>Deteriorating Facilities</u>: Some of you have toured our facilities and witnessed the
  aged, deteriorating, and increasingly overcrowded conditions, which present serious
  safety and operational challenges every day for staff and inmates across the state.
   Your committees have been very supportive in funding various CIP requests that are
  allowing PSD to begin addressing these conditions.
- Population Management: Since the passage of the Justice Reinvestment Act (JRI) in 2012, PSD has made significant progress and improvement in the processing and rehabilitative programming of inmates and parole violators. JRI-inspired operational changes have also resulted in increased amounts of restitution collected from offenders, increased numbers of inmates assigned to re-entry programs, and realigned programming for long term inmates.

PSD's implementation of recommended JRI initiatives has not resulted in similar positive outcomes as it pertains to our pre-trial detainee population. We continue to work diligently with our partners in the Judiciary on alternatives to extended pre-trial incarceration.

- Emerging Community Policing Needs: The Sheriff Division has been working collaboratively with mental health and community service providers in addressing the residentially-challenged in order to forge a more effective response. State law enforcement presence in support of multiple efforts has emerged as an ongoing need, as well as, available law enforcement protection of areas of state jurisdiction and property.
- Emergency Appropriation: The Department is again submitting an emergency appropriation bill to provide funds to continue temporary housing of 248 inmates at a non-state facility for an additional six months (January 2019-June 2019), while capital improvements are made to the Halawa Correctional Facility, under DAGS Job No. Job No. 12-27-5644 security electronics and hardware repairs and improvements. The request is for \$3,424,057.
- Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) Replacement: The urgent need for the replacement and relocation of the current OCCC remains a top priority for PSD.

PSD, in partnership with Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS), completed the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) with the Governor's acceptance and the selection of the Halawa Animal Quarantine Site as the home of the new OCCC.

<u>Budget Request</u>: The Department's operating budget submittal for FB 2019-2021 totals 23.0 general-funded positions and \$2,737,214 and 21.0 Inter-Departmental funded-positions and \$1,086,455 in the 1<sup>st</sup> year. For the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, our submittal totals 23.0 general-funded positions and \$2,074,031 and 21.0 Inter-Departmental-funded positions and \$1,926,339. Our requests are as follows:

- Establish 2.0 Adult Corrections Office III positions and funds for the suicide watch at PSD 405- Hawaii Community Correctional Center
- Conversion of the temporary Farm Manager positions at PSD 403- Kulani
   Correctional Facility and PSD 404 Waiawa Correctional Facility
- Deletion of the Inmate Store Account ceilings for PSD 402 Halawa Correctional Facility, PSD 404 – Waiawa Correctional Facility and PSD 407 – Oahu Community Correctional Center per Act 3, SLH 2018

#### Law Enforcement:

- Recurring funds of \$195,000 general funds for Vehicle replacement for PSD 503-Sheriffs
- Establishment of 4.0 Deputy Sheriff positions and funds for Oahu to support the homeless operations efforts of the State
- Establishment of 21.0 positions and inter-departmental funds for staffing of the new Ewa and Mauka Concourse Expansion at the Daniel K. Inouye International Airport

#### General Administration:

- Establishment of 3.0 temporary positions for CALEA certification assigned to the Training and Staff Development Office
- Full funding for 1.0 IT Specialist position authorized by Act 53, SLH 2018
- Funding for a new Corrections Collaboration System that will replace the existing corrections database

The Department's total additional request for Fiscal Biennium 2019-21 is for 44.0 permanent positions, 1.0 temporary position, and \$7,676,601 for all means of funding (See Table 4). In total, the Department requests 2,749.60 permanent positions, 49.0 temporary positions and \$594,643,021 in operating funds for Fiscal Biennium 2019-21 (See Table 2) for all means of funding.

The Department's capital improvement program (CIP) requests total \$52.793 million for Fiscal Biennium 2019-21 (See Table 15).

We look forward to working closely with your Committees in this 2019 Legislative Session.

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Crime Victim Compensation Commission ("the Commission") was established in 1967 to mitigate the suffering and financial impact experienced by victims of violent crime by providing compensation to pay un-reimbursed crime-related expenses. Many victims of violent crime could not afford to pay their medical bills, receive needed mental health or rehabilitative services, or bury a loved one if compensation were not available.

The mission of the Crime Victim Compensation Commission is to equitably and efficiently provide crime victims with the services due to them under Hawai`i law. In doing so, the Commission treats every victim and survivor with dignity and respect, acknowledging the tremendous impact that violent crime has upon crime victims and our society.

The Commission is a quasi-judicial body which is attached to the Department of Public Safety for administrative purposes only.

The Commission's compensation program is specially funded through non-tax revenue. The primary sources of non-tax revenue funding are the collection of compensation fees assessed by judges against criminal offenders and a 60% federal matching grant.

Maintaining a consistent and adequate source of non-tax revenue to fund compensation for crime victims and operating expenses remains an important fiscal issue facing the Commission. No State general funds have been appropriated for victim compensation since FY 2003. The Crime Victim Compensation Fee<sup>1</sup> (the "Compensation Fee") is the

Commission's primary source of non-tax revenue and its assessment and collection is vital to the Commission remaining fiscally self sufficient.

#### Justice Reinvestment Initiative and Restitution

In 2003, the Commission initiated a pilot project to collect and disburse restitution from inmates and parolees to their crime victims. Since the Restitution Project was initiated, the Commission has opened 8,995 restitution and compensation fee cases and collected \$4,845,944.57 of restitution for crime victims as of November 30, 2018. In 2012, as part of JRI, the project became permanent. JRI legislation enhanced restitution collection from inmates and parolees and provided the Commission with funding to create a database to improve the efficiency of restitution collection. With the completion of the database, the Commission worked with the Council of State Governments (CSG) to conduct an in-depth data analysis of restitution orders. In February 2018, the Commission worked with the Office of the Lieutenant Governor to convene a meeting where CSG presented their findings for policy makes and practitioners.

The Commission assisted the Department of Public Safety (PSD) in securing a federal Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) grant, through the Hawai'i Department of the Attorney General, to centralize PSD's restitution operations to identify restitution cases to ensure timely collection of court-ordered inmate restitution owed to victims and payees. The grant provides funding for two full-time specialists housed in PSD to coordinate/manage restitution collections from the facilities working with the Commission's JRI staff, and to assist victims and the public with information and referrals regarding victim rights, restitution, compensation, the criminal justice process, and resources in the community.

In October 2018, the Commission partnered with CSG to host a two-day training, "The Hawai'i Experience: Improving Restitution Management, Helping Victims Recover," for state agency representatives from five states – California, Delaware, New Mexico, Pennsylvania and Wyoming. The victim advocates gathered to learn from Hawai'i's success with improving the management of victim restitution through the effective use of policy, data, agency leadership and workforce, and interagency coordination. The training was highlighted in a post and article on the CSG website.

The leadership and commitment of the PSD Director has made a significant impact on restitution collection from furloughed inmates. Since PSD implemented new

offense as follows: (1) Not less than \$105 nor more than \$505 for a felony; \$55 for a misdemeanor; and (3) \$30 for a petty misdemeanor.

restitution policies and procedures in July 2015, the Commission has collected \$400,916.54 in restitution from furloughed inmates through June 30, 2018.

#### Mass Violence

The Mass Violence and Terrorism Response Project is working to ensure that the Commission and other victim service providers are integrated into the County's and State Incident Command Response models to provide timely crime victim services and to ensure access to compensation services for incident victims and survivors.

The Commission applied for and received a grant from the Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime, Training and Technical Assistance Center, which provided a consultant to provide training. The Commission, in partnership with the consultant, the FBI, the U.S. Attorney's Office, and the four county Prosecuting Attorneys' Victim Assistance Programs held two-day conferences on Oahu and the Big Island and assisted Maui with their conference to bring together the victim service community along with first responders to address a mass violence and terrorism incident protocol and response. The conference paved the way for the Commission and other victim service providers to be integrated into the County and State Incident Command Response model to ensure victims and incident survivors are provided with timely, efficient, and compassionate victim services and access to compensation.

The Commission received a second grant from the Department of Justice, Office for Victims of Crime, Training and Technical Assistance Center to assist with developing the State's victim services response plan to a mass violence incident. Subsequently, the Commission worked with the Office of the Lieutenant Governor to convene a meeting with key government agency representatives and private organizations to identify existing resources for mass violence response and gaps in services for victims and impacted communities.

As a result of the above meeting, the consultant worked with the Commission to draft a plan that provides the framework for coordinating and mobilizing victim services in mass casualty crime events. The proposed plan will be disseminated to stakeholders for their input and the final plan will become the template for an Annex to the State of Hawai'i Emergency Operations Plan.

The Commission and the consultant have also drafted a Memorandum of Agreement (MOU) between the four county Prosecuting Attorneys outlining their shared commitments to provide victim assistance in incidents of mass violence and terrorism. The MOU has been disseminated and is currently under review by the county Prosecuting Attorneys.

The Commission is currently revising its application to create a short-form application to enable the Commission to rapidly respond and assist victims traumatized by a mass violence incident. The Commission continues to update its mass violence procedures and to view and update the materials in its Mass Violence Project kit which enables the Commission to mobilize and respond quickly to an incident.

#### FEDERAL FUNDS

The Commission is not currently at risk of losing federal funds.

#### **BUDGET REQUEST**

The Commission's budget is developed by reviewing prior years' compensation award data to determine compensation payouts together with fixed monthly and annual payroll and operating expenses.

The Commission is not requesting any changes to its current budget.

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Hawaii Paroling Authority (HPA) is a quasi-judicial body (PSD 611 – Determinations (HPA-D)), which is attached to the Department of Public Safety (Department) for administrative purposes only. The mission of the HPA is to serve as the central paroling authority for the State of Hawaii and is responsible for the administration of and discharge of all parole and community supervision programs within the HPA's jurisdiction. The HPA determines appropriate minimum term(s) of imprisonment; whether an eligible individual is in-fact ready for release on parole; and, whether to revoke or suspend parole and recommit parole violators to prison. In addition, the HPA can at its discretion can grant early discharges to persons released on parole providing specific criterion has been met by the paroled person.

Under the general direction and guidance of the Chairman, the parole division (PSD 612 - Supervision and Counseling (HPA SC)), directs and maintains the operational work units of the HPA and provides supervision to persons granted parole so as to assure their behavior conforms to established standards, and to provide guidance, counseling and assistance as may be required to aid their successful reintegration back into the community and rehabilitation.

#### Justice Reinvestment Initiative (ACT 139)

The Council on State Governments (CSG) has been assisting the HPA and other State agencies with the implementation of ACT 139 (Justice Reinvestment Initiative (JRI)), to include the development of goals and objectives, development and implementation of various performance measures to assist agencies and their respective leadership to determine how the initiative is progressing. The JRI is currently on-going. The HPA has compiled data and provided it to the CSG pertaining to the implementation of the provisions of Section 7 (HRS §353-66) of ACT 139 with respect to the 6-month maximum parole revocation period for "first-time" parole violators.

The following are highlights of HPA's activities:

- 1. In addition to the cooperative agreement HPA entered into with the Department to consider the re-parole of first-time technical parole violators after 90 150 days of incarceration as well as the review of cases supported by the Department for early parole consideration, the HPA has implemented the provisions of ACT 139.
  - In order to reduce recidivism among this population of parolees, the HPA requires inmates to complete all Department RAD recommended programs such as KASHBOX and/or other institutional programs designed to assist them with their effort to remain crime free. This includes recommending mental health treatment and/or dual diagnosis treatment when appropriate. In addition, depending on the nature of the parole violation, the HPA may require parolees to complete residential drug treatment and/or participation in programs in the community as a condition of re-parole.
- 2. The Authority works cooperatively with the Department in reviewing inmate cases and providing administrative reviews if they are within 7 to 12 months of their Tentative Parole Date. This action does not guarantee a release on parole.
- 3. The Authority now generally schedules minimum sentence hearings within three to four months after sentencing by the courts versus the prior practice of five to

- six months. This has expedited the reclassification of inmates to move minimum custody inmates out of higher security prison beds to more appropriate levels of custody, which in turn reduces the costs of incarceration.
- 4. The Authority now schedules parole and minimum hearings to accommodate inmate transfers between facilities and to eliminate costly movement of inmates to hearings. The hearings are held at all correctional facilities statewide, including Kulani Correctional Facility that began earlier this year.
- 5. Although the HPA is a relatively small agency with only 68 positions statewide (64 Full-Time and 4 Part-Time), the impact the HPA has on the overall criminal justice system and the lives of offenders is significant. As an example, during FY 2018 (July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018), the HPA conducted 1,654 minimum term hearings for 493 offenders, held 2,940 parole consideration hearings, and conducted 413 parole violation hearing. This is in addition to conducting administrative hearings and reviews on 540 matters regarding reduction of minimum terms of imprisonment, parole suspensions, discharge consideration, and pardon applications.
- 6. Parole violation hearings are now routinely scheduled approximately 30-40 days after the retake on a warrant of arrest. This has reduced the number of violators "pending hearing" and being held in higher security prison beds. In the case of first time parole violators who qualify under the provisions of ACT 139, parole consideration hearings are usually scheduled to take place within four (4) to five (5) months after the violator's return to custody.
- 7. The Authority reviews individual cases of sentenced felons with immigration detainers. The Authority works closely with the Immigration, Customs, and Enforcement (ICE) staff of the Department of Homeland Security to review all inmates who are subject to deportation. When appropriate, inmates are paroled to Federal custody for immediate deportation to their countries of origin.
- 8. The authority also saw a notable increase in 2018 in the number of offenders requiring sex offender determination hearings.

#### FEDERAL FUNDS

At this time, the HPA does not have any federal grants, but we consistently apply for federal funding when available, and ensure that state funding will not be affected should HPA receive federal funding that is later discontinued.

#### **BUDGET REQUEST**

#### No additional funding requested.

The following are the parameters used to determine the budget priorities of HPA:

1. The overall mission of public safety is reinforced if, prior to parole, the inmate has met all of his programming needs, maintained good institutional conduct, has a low risk of recidivism, and has a good support system.

- 2. The HPA must ensure that all inmates are reconsidered for parole every 12 months after their initial parole denial. This measure relates to the proper treatment of inmates and ensures that statutory requirements are being followed. To ensure statutory requirements are met, the HPA normally schedules reconsideration hearings 11 months following the initial denial of parole and have begun to schedule hearing earlier when warranted.
- 3. The overall measure of public safety is reinforced when a parolee is granted a final discharge because the parolee must have met the criteria set for discharge; i.e., at least five consecutive years of success on parole, no new crimes, and good stability factors (family, residence, and/or employment), or the expiration of maximum sentence. The HPA routinely considers parolees for early discharge prior to five consecutive years of success on parole for
  - those that have demonstrated above average successful reintegration back into the community (i.e., two to three consecutive years of success on parole, no new crimes, and excellent stability factors (family, residence, and/or employment)).
- 4. The number of inmates that go beyond their expiration of minimum sentence generally indicates not having met their correctional programming, having poor conduct records in prison, having inadequate parole plans, and/or being deemed a high risk to re-offend.

The HPA is committed to continue to work with the Department in achieving the JRI goals and objectives within the resources available to us. We look forward to working with your committee this 2018 Legislative Session.
