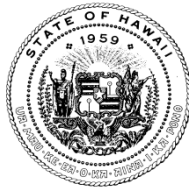

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.**

Chair Yamane, Vice Chair Todd, and members of the Committee. The Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism (DBEDT) **strongly supports** SB1188, SD1 that makes an emergency appropriation to the Hawaii Community Development Authority (HCDA) to provide funds for payroll, fringe benefits, and administrative costs.

This bill is necessary to keep the 23 hard-working staff members funded through the end of the fiscal year. The current year's budget inadvertently left out fringe benefit costs, so this bill seeks to raise the spending ceiling on HCDA's Revolving Fund to pay for salary and fringe benefits. DBEDT requests the sum of \$1,115,853 be inserted into the bill. This measure has no fiscal impact on the State's General Fund.

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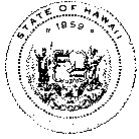

Chair Yamane, Vice Chair Todd, and Members of the Committee.

The Hawaii Community Development Authority (HCDA) supports SB 1188 SD1 that makes an emergency appropriation to HCDA to provide funds for payroll, fringe benefits, and administrative costs.

Without this bill, HCDA will run out of money to fund employee salaries on April 15, 2019.

HCDA staff salaries were funded in the current year's budget out of HCDA's Revolving Funds; however, the current year appropriation did not include money for fringe benefits. *SB 1188 SD1 is necessary to fully fund staff salaries and fringe benefits through this fiscal year 2019.* In Section 3 of the bill, we are asking for an appropriation of \$1,115,853.

It should be noted that this bill has no fiscal impact on the General Fund as it simply raises the spending cap on HCDA's Revolving Fund.
