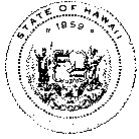

Chair Dela Cruz, Vice Chair Keith-Agaran and members of the Committee. The Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism (DBEDT) **strongly supports** SB1188 that makes an emergency appropriation to the Hawaii Community Development Authority (HCDA) to provide funds for payroll, fringe benefits, and administrative costs.

This bill is necessary to keep the 23 hard-working staff members funded through the end of the fiscal year. The current year's budget inadvertently left out fringe benefit costs, so this bill seeks to raise the spending ceiling on HCDA's Revolving Fund to pay for salary and fringe benefits. As such, this SB 1188 has no fiscal impact on the state's General Fund.

payroll, fringe benefits, and administrative costs.

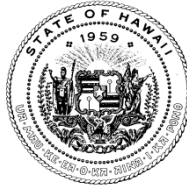
Without this bill, we will not be able to meet payroll for our employees
through the end of the fiscal year.

HCDA staff salaries were funded in the current year's budget out of
HCDA's Revolving Funds; however, the current year appropriation did not include
money for fringe benefits. SB 1188 is necessary to fully fund staff salaries and
fringe benefits through this fiscal year.

It should be noted that this bill has no fiscal impact on the General Fund as
it simply raises the spending cap on HCDA's Revolving Fund.
