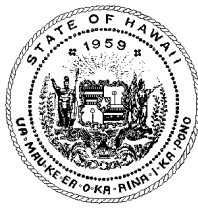

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) has reviewed Senate Bill (SB) 596. While PSD appreciates the bill's intent to provide Capital Improvement Project (CIP) funds, which were not included in the Supplemental FY 2019 budget, the Department respectfully asks that the Committee support the Governor's FB 2019-21 CIP Budget Request, submitted for PSD, as it reflects the Department's current project priorities.

In addition, PSD asks the Committee to amend Line 15 on Page 2 of SB 596, to appropriately reflect the expending agency, "public safety" instead of "defense".
