- 2. The goals and objectives related to the request; AUP has plans to enhance the outrigger canoe scene, as previously stated, to all the islands of Hawaii. The funds related to this request will assist in AUP promoting races that will entice tourism and those from other clubs around the world to participate. But moreover, the funds from this request are to benefit the

public of Hawaii and Moloka'l by building an outrigger canoe paddling epicenter. This facility would host, educate, and lodge paddlers from all of the world. The ultimate goal with the funds is to create a central location for canoes and paddlers to meet on the island for the world's grandest distance canoe races: Kaiwi Channel OC1 world championship, Maui Jim Challenge, Na Wahine of Ke Kai, Moloka'i Hoe, and various SUP races that start on Moloka'i. This facility would store the canoes for the participants, have a pavilion to host pre-race meetings, and provide camping spots for the participants, as well.

3. The public purpose and need to be served;

The funds from this grant would allow local Moloka'i residents the contracts to build and make sure the facility is ready for the upcoming race season. The land would be purchased and construction would commence with the funds from this grant. As well, local Hawaii residents would benefit from the opportunity to use the facility for meetings, camps, and recreation. As well, the public would have a secure location to store their canoes and equipment leading up the event or race they intend to participate in.

4. Describe the target population to be served; and

The target population to be served by this grant is the Hawaii and worldwide outrigger canoe paddlers. The funds from this grant with create a facility that will benefit Hawaiian outrigger canoe paddlers, as well as worldwide paddlers.

This facility will be on the island of Moloka'i but will help those who visit from other islands and around the world.

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This pavilion will be an open pavilion. A simple structure with a roof, support beams, and floor. There will educational boards on a few panel with the history of distance outrigger canoe paddling. The facility will be ADA compliant. Seating will be built to house about 50-75 people. There will be outhouses available, but no running water will be necessary. Along with a pavilion a canoe halau will be built to hold and house the outrigger canoes for the participants before the events. This will be built out of storage containers and engineered trusses.

Once this project is funded, from receiving the funds to completion should be approximately 4 months. This would provide ample time to get bids from licensed/bonded companies on Moloka'i to completion of the facilities. This would provide enough time to reach out to local Hawaiian and worldwide canoe clubs to let them know the facility and services are available prior to the distance one man, SUP, and 6 man season.
