Dear Senate President Kouchi and Speaker Saiki:

The University of Hawai'i Professional Assembly (UHPA) and the employer reached an agreement concerning collective bargaining for Unit 7 (University of Hawai'i Faculty) on May 12, 2020, pursuant to a contract re-opener, which does not require ratification. In accordance with Section 89-10(b), cost items must be submitted to the Legislature. Because the agreement was not reached in time for costs to be included in the biennium budget, an Administration Proposal was submitted to the 2020 Legislature. The estimated costs are as follows:

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
3 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
4 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

5 SECTION 2. There are appropriated or authorized from the
6 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining
7 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 all
9 collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated
10 with the exclusive bargaining representative of collective
11 bargaining unit (7):

1 SECTION 3. Funds appropriated by this part shall be
2 allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate state
3 departments for expenditure in the respective fiscal year for
4 the purposes of this part.

6 SECTION 4. There are appropriated or authorized from the
7 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining
8 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may
9 be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 the salary
10 increases and other cost adjustments authorized by chapter 89C,
11 Hawaii Revised Statutes, for state officers and employees who
12 are excluded from collective bargaining and belong to the same
13 compensation plans as those officers and employees within
14 bargaining unit (7):

20 SECTION 5. Funds appropriated or authorized by this part
21 shall be allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate

1 state departments for expenditure in the respective fiscal year
2 for the purposes of this part.

3 PART III

4 SECTION 6. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
5 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
6 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
7 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
8 from the respective funds.

9 SECTION 7. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
10 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2021, shall
11 lapse as of that date.

12 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
