
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE TRANSPORTATION
TO REPLACE JERSEY BARRIERS FRONTING THE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION HARBORS DIVISION BUILDING ON SOUTH NIMITZ
HIGHWAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that after the attacks of
2 September 11, 2001, jersey barriers were placed on the Nimitz
3 highway side of the department of transportation harbors
4 division offices as a security precaution. The barriers were
5 later painted green, which improved their appearance, but they
6 remain unsightly.

7 The legislature further finds that the department of
8 transportation harbors division has identified aesthetic
9 alternatives to the existing precast jersey barriers fronting
10 the harbors division offices that meet Federal Highway
11 Administration requirements for longitudinal barrier
12 installations on the National Highway System as well as
13 compliance with crash test criteria embodied in the National
14 Cooperative Highway Research Program 350.
