## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 281, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "§281- Reporting of shipments by carriers. (a)  
5 Notwithstanding section 281-33, any express carrier company,  
6 common or contract carrier, or other person that transports  
7 liquor from outside the State for delivery in the State to any  
8 person, except those having a class 1 manufacturer license or  
9 class 3 wholesale dealer license, shall prepare and file a  
10 monthly report with the liquor commission of each county in  
11 which the delivery is made. The report shall contain the  
12 following information:

- 13           (1) The known wine, beer, alcohol, or other liquor  
14           shipments containing the name of the express carrier  
15           company, common or contract carrier, or other person  
16           making the report;  
17           (2) The period of time covered by the report;



- 1        (3) The name and business address of the consignor of the
- 2                wine, beer, alcohol, or other liquor;
- 3        (4) The name and address of each consignee of the wine,
- 4                beer, alcohol, or other liquor;
- 5        (5) The weight of the package delivered to each consignee;
- 6        (6) A unique tracking number; and
- 7        (7) The date of each delivery.
- 8        (b) Reports received by a county liquor commission under
- 9 this section shall be subject to chapter 92F.
- 10        (c) Any county liquor commission may provide reports
- 11 received to any other department or agency.
- 12        (d) Upon written request of a county liquor commission,
- 13 information or records supporting the report shall be filed with
- 14 the requesting liquor commission within thirty days. Any
- 15 records containing information relating to reports shall be
- 16 preserved for four years.
- 17        (e) The liquor commission in each county may adopt rules
- 18 necessary to carry out the purposes of this section."

19        SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
