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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH BUDGET.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide funding  
2 for the operations of the department of health for the fiscal  
3 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.

4           SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as may  
5 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated  
6 herein, are hereby appropriated or authorized, as the case may  
7 be, from the means of financing specified to the department of  
8 health for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and  
9 ending June 30, 2021. The total expenditures and the number of  
10 positions in each fiscal year of the biennium shall not exceed  
11 the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each fiscal  
12 year, except as provided elsewhere in this Act or as provided by  
13 general law.

14           Unless otherwise clear from the context, as used in this  
15 Act:

16           "Expending agency" means the executive department,  
17 independent commission, bureau, office, board, or other



1 establishment of the state government (other than the  
2 legislature, Office of Hawaiian Affairs, and judiciary), the  
3 political subdivisions of the State, or any quasi-public  
4 institution supported in whole or in part by state funds, which  
5 is authorized to expend specified appropriations made by this  
6 Act.

7 Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency,  
8 shall mean the following:

9 HTH Department of Health

10 "Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which  
11 funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the  
12 programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations  
13 are followed by letter symbols. Such letter symbols, where  
14 used, shall have the following meanings:

15 A general funds

16 B special funds

17 N federal funds

18 P other federal funds

19 W revolving funds

20 "Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent  
21 and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a



1 particular program during a specified period or periods, as  
2 denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent  
3 positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent  
4 positions.

5 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific  
6 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization  
7 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the  
8 organization number for the program.
