
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide funding
2 for the operations of the Hawaii public housing authority for
3 the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30,
4 2021, under the purview of the house of representatives standing
5 committee on housing.

6 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
7 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
8 herein, are hereby appropriated or authorized, as the case may
9 be, from the means of financing specified to the expending
10 agencies designated for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1,
11 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The total expenditures and the
12 number of positions in each fiscal year of the biennium shall
13 not exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each
14 fiscal year, except as provided elsewhere in this Act or as
15 provided by general law.


