
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
3 and to read as follows:

4 "Contract with the State" means an agreement with the
5 State where a person:

6 (1) Has agreed to accept or has accepted legislatively
7 appropriated funds including general obligation bonds,
8 grants-in-aid, special purpose revenue bonds, or other
9 methods of financing that exceed an aggregate of
10 \$ within a fiscal year; or

11 (2) Has agreed to receive or render, or has received or
12 rendered, services to the State;

13 provided that "contract with the State" shall not include
14 permanent, full-time state employees."

15 SECTION 2. Section 11-354, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:



1 "(a) Except as provided in subsection (b), no person shall
2 solicit a contribution in a government facility that is used for
3 the discharge of official duties by an officer or employee of
4 the State or county[-], or in a facility owned, rented, leased,
5 subleased, or associated with any person that has entered into a
6 contract with the State."

7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.

Campaign Fundraising; Restrictions; Contract With The State

Description:

Prohibits campaign fundraising on the property of persons that have accepted legislatively appropriated funds that exceed an unspecified aggregate value or received or rendered services to the State. (HB1382 HD2)

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
