
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,
AND TOURISM BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 **PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

2 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to adjust the
3 operating budget for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 2019,
4 and ending June 30, 2021, using the Supplemental Appropriations
5 Act of 2018 as a basis for the appropriations, authorizations,
6 and positions, for certain state executive branch programs under
7 the purview of the house of representatives standing committee
8 on water, land, and Hawaiian affairs.

9 SECTION 2. Unless otherwise clear from the context, as
10 used in this Act:

11 "Expending agency" means the department of business,
12 economic development, and tourism.

13 Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency or
14 a house of representatives standing committee, shall mean the
15 following:



1 BED Department of business, economic development, and
2 tourism

3 WLH House of representatives standing committee on water,
4 land, and Hawaiian affairs

5 "Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which
6 funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the
7 programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations
8 are followed by letter symbols. The letter symbols, where used,
9 shall have the following meanings:

10 A General funds

11 N Federal funds

12 W Revolving funds

13 "Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent
14 and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a
15 particular program during a specified period or periods, as
16 denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent
17 positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent
18 positions.

19 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific
20 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization



1 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the
2 organization number for the program.

3 **PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS**

4 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
5 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
6 herein, are hereby appropriated or authorized, as the case may
7 be, from the means of financing specified to the expending
8 agency designated for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1,
9 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The total expenditures and the
10 number of positions in each fiscal year of the biennium shall
11 not exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each
12 fiscal year, except as provided elsewhere in this Act or as
13 provided by general law. Negative amounts reflect a reduction
14 in appropriations, authorizations, or number of positions, as
15 the case may be, from the amounts or positions appropriated or
16 authorized in the fiscal year 2018-2019 base budget, otherwise
17 known as the Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2018.

1 PART III. MISCELLANEOUS AND EFFECTIVE DATE

2 SECTION 4. If any portion of this Act or its application
3 to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for
4 any reason, then the legislature declares that the remainder of
5 this Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be
6 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
7 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
8 be expended to fulfill the objective of the appropriation to the
9 extent possible.

10 SECTION 5. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other
11 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may
12 correct the errors.

13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
