
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-NINTH DISTRICT OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$435,120,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6 the thirty-ninth representative district, as follows:

20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.


