
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-355, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as
3 follows:
4 " ~~[+] §11-355 [±]~~ **Contributions by state and county**
5 **contractors prohibited.** (a) It shall be unlawful for any
6 person, and officers and board members of the person, who enters
7 into any contract with the State, any of the counties, or any
8 department or agency thereof either for the rendition of
9 personal services, goods, or utilities, the buying of property,
10 or furnishing of any material, supplies, or equipment to the
11 State, any of the counties, any department or agency thereof, or
12 for selling any land or building to the State, any of the
13 counties, or any department or agency thereof, if payment for
14 the performance of the contract or payment for material,
15 supplies, equipment, land, property, ~~[e±]~~ building, goods,
16 utilities, or services is to be made in whole or in part from
17 funds appropriated by the legislative body, at any time between



1 the execution of the contract through the completion of the
2 contract, to:

- 3 (1) Directly or indirectly make any contribution, or
4 promise expressly or impliedly to make any
5 contribution to any candidate committee or
6 noncandidate committee, or to any candidate or to any
7 person for any political purpose or use; or
8 (2) Knowingly solicit any contribution from any person for
9 any purpose during any period."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
