
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,
AND TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 **PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

2 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish the
3 operating budget for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 2019,
4 and ending June 30, 2021, for state executive branch programs
5 under the purview of the house of representatives standing
6 committee on economic development and business.

7 SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS. Unless otherwise clear from the
8 context, as used in this Act:

9 "Expending agency" means the executive department,
10 independent commission, bureau, office, board, or other
11 establishment of the state government (other than the
12 legislature, office of Hawaiian affairs, and judiciary), the
13 political subdivisions of the State, or any quasi-public
14 institution supported in whole or in part by state funds, which
15 is authorized to expend specified appropriations made by this
16 Act.



1 Abbreviations, where used to denote the expending agency or
2 a standing committee of the house of representatives, shall mean
3 the following:

4 BED department of business, economic development, and
5 tourism

6 EDB House of representatives standing committee on
7 economic development and business.

8 "Means of financing" or "MOF" means the source from which
9 funds are appropriated or authorized to be expended for the
10 programs and projects specified in this Act. All appropriations
11 are followed by letter symbols. The letter symbols, where used,
12 shall have the following meanings:

- 13 A General funds
- 14 B Special funds
- 15 P Other federal funds
- 16 W Revolving funds

17 "Position ceiling" means the maximum number of permanent
18 and temporary full-time equivalent positions authorized for a
19 particular program during a specified period or periods, as
20 denoted by an asterisk for permanent full-time equivalent
21 positions and a pound sign for temporary full-time equivalent
22 positions.



1 "Program ID" means the unique identifier for the specific
2 program and consists of the abbreviation for the organization
3 responsible for carrying out the program followed by the
4 organization number for the program.

5 **PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS**

6 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. The following sums, or so much
7 thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and
8 programs designated herein, are hereby appropriated or
9 authorized, as the case may be, from the means of financing
10 specified to the expending agencies designated for the fiscal
11 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The
12 total expenditures and the number of positions in each fiscal
13 year of the biennium shall not exceed the sums and the position
14 ceilings indicated for each fiscal year, except as provided
15 elsewhere in this Act or as provided by general law.

9 145);

10 (2) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
11 fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021
13 for Hawaii technology development corporation
14 operational funding (BED 143);

15 (3) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
16 fiscal year 2019-2020 and \$ or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for a
18 creative lab coworking space and studio at the
19 entrepreneurs sandbox and foreign trade zone (BED
20 105);

1 (4) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for

15 (11) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
16 fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021
18 for the manufacturing assistance program (BED 143);

19 (12) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
20 fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much

1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021
2 for the excelerator program (BED 143);

3 (13) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
4 fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021
6 for the Hawaii office of naval research program (BED
7 143);

8 (14) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
9 fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021
11 for fringe benefits to reach a sixty per cent rate
12 (BED 107);

13 (15) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
14 fiscal year 2019-2020 and \$ or so much thereof
15 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for one
16 cable landing project manager position (BED 142);

17 (16) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
18 fiscal year 2019-2020 and \$ or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to
20 establish an office in Guangzhou, Guangdong, China to
21 promote trade in Hawaii (BED 100);



1 (17) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
 2 fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much
 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021
 4 for retention of the Taipei office, with costs shared
 5 with the Taiwan government (BED 100);

6 (18) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
 7 fiscal year 2019-2020 and \$ or so much thereof
 8 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to
 9 reinstate a position for marketing and certification
 10 FOTR enterprise zone and opportunity zone programs
 11 (BED 100); and

12 (19) \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
 13 fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much
 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021
 15 for census outreach support to obtain more federal
 16 funding (BED 130).

PART III. MISCELLANEOUS AND EFFECTIVE DATE

18 SECTION 5. If any portion of this Act or its application
 19 to any person, entity, or circumstance is held to be invalid for
 20 any reason, then the legislature declares that the remainder of
 21 the Act and each and every other provision thereof shall not be



1 affected thereby. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
2 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
3 be expended to fulfill the objective of the appropriation to the
4 extent possible.

5 SECTION 6. If manifest clerical, typographical, or other
6 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor may
7 correct the errors.

8 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
