# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "§328-           Customized patient medication package. (a) A  
5 pharmacy may provide a customized patient medication package to  
6 any patient of an institutional facility or any member of the  
7 general public; provided that:

8           (1) The pharmacy has obtained the consent of the patient,  
9           patient's caregiver, patient's guardian, or  
10           prescribing practitioner;

11           (2) The consent is accompanied by the patient's current  
12           prescription; and

13           (3) The customized patient medication package meets the  
14           requirements of section 328-16.

15           (b) As used in this section:



1        "Customized patient medication package" means a package  
2 that is prepared by a pharmacist for a specific patient and  
3 contains one or more prescribed solid oral dosage forms.

4        "Institutional facility" has the same meaning as in section  
5 461-1.

6        "Pharmacist" has the same meaning as "registered  
7 pharmacist" in section 461-1.

8        "Pharmacy" has the same meaning as in section 461-1."

9        SECTION 2.    New statutory material is underscored.

10       SECTION 3.    This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.



**Report Title:**

Prescription Drugs; Pharmacy; Customized Patient Medication Packages

**Description:**

Authorizes a pharmacy to provide a customized patient medication package to any patient of an institutional facility or any member of the general public upon consent, with a valid prescription, and in compliance with labeling and dispensing requirements. Takes effect 07/01/3000. (HD1)
