# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 11-340, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3           "(c) Subsection (b) notwithstanding, if a candidate  
4 committee does not file the [~~second~~] preliminary primary report,  
5 due ten calendar days before a primary, initial special, or  
6 initial nonpartisan election, or the preliminary general report,  
7 due ten calendar days before a general, subsequent special, or  
8 subsequent nonpartisan election, or if a noncandidate committee  
9 does not file the preliminary primary report or the second  
10 preliminary general report by the due date, the fine, if  
11 assessed, shall not exceed \$300 per day; provided that, in  
12 aggregate:

13           (1) The fine shall not exceed twenty-five per cent of the  
14 total amount of contributions or expenditures,  
15 whichever is greater, for the period covered by the  
16 report; and

17           (2) The minimum fine, if assessed, shall be \$300."
