
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 708-800, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "property" to read as
3 follows:
4 ""Property" means any money, personal property, real
5 property, thing in action, evidence of debt or contract, or
6 article of value of any kind[-], and includes intellectual
7 property and property that is stored in an electronic medium and
8 is retrievable in a perceivable form. Commodities of a public
9 utility nature such as gas, electricity, steam, and water
10 constitute property, but the supplying of such a commodity to
11 premises from an outside source by means of wires, pipes,
12 conduits, or other equipment shall be deemed a rendition of a
13 service rather than a sale or delivery of property."

14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16 begun before its effective date.
