
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that increased funding is
2 necessary to support agriculture in the State.

3 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
4 moneys to the agricultural development and plant industry
5 divisions of the department of agriculture.

6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to
9 increase biosecurity at airports and harbors; support small
10 local farmers; and promote the safety of workers and the public
11 in relation to agriculture, invasive species, and native
12 ecosystems to be allocated as follows:

13 (1) \$ to the agricultural development division;
14 and

15 (2) \$ to the plant industry division,
16 of the department of agriculture.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the
4 funds appropriated by this Act may be transferred, with the
5 approval of the governor, to the Supplemental Appropriations Act
6 of 2020, for program execution and expenditure.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2150.
