
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2020.

3 SECTION 2. Act 38, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, is amended
4 by amending part II to read as follows:

5 "PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS

6 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
7 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
8 herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of
9 funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium
10 beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The total
11 expenditures and the number of permanent and temporary positions
12 established in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not
13 exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each
14 year, except as provided in this Act.

3 "PART IV. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

4 SECTION 8. The sum of [~~\$9,355,000~~] \$ _____
5 appropriated or authorized in part II of this Act for capital
6 improvement projects shall be expended by the judiciary for the
7 projects listed below; provided that several related or similar
8 projects may be combined into a single project, if a combination
9 is advantageous or convenient for implementation; provided
10 further that the total cost of the projects thus combined shall
11 not exceed the total of the sums specified for the projects
12 separately. The amount after each cost element and the total
13 funding for each project listed in this part are in thousands of
14 dollars.

1 SECTION 4. Act 38, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, is amended
2 by amending part V to read as follows:

3 "PART V. ISSUANCE OF BONDS

4 SECTION 9. General obligation bonds may be issued, as
5 provided by law, to yield the amount that may be necessary to
6 finance projects authorized in part II and listed in part V of
7 this Act; provided that the sum of the general obligation bonds
8 so issued shall not exceed [~~\$9,355,000.~~] \$ _____."

9 SECTION 5. If any portion of this Act or its application
10 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any
11 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall
12 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
13 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
14 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to
15 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the
16 extent possible.

17 SECTION 6. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or
18 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice
19 may correct the error. All changes made pursuant to this
20 section shall be reported to the legislature at its next regular
21 session.



1 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
