
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-FIFTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$78,450,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 fifth representative district, as follows:

7 1. Lehua elementary school

8 Construction and equipment for
9 administration/library building and
10 restoration of D building to
11 accommodate classrooms.

12 Construction \$7,000,000

13 Equipment \$500,000

14 Total funding \$7,500,000

15 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
16 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 2. Pearl City high school
2 Design and construction for electrical
3 upgrades to meet technological need of
4 growing academies and update of aging
5 transformers.

6	Design	\$1,000,000
7	Construction	\$5,000,000
8	Total funding	\$6,000,000

9 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
10 shall be expended by the department of education.

11 3. Pearl City high school
12 Design and construction for resurfacing
13 of tennis courts.

17 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
18 shall be expended by the department of education.

19 4. Pearl City high school
20 Design, construction, and equipment for
21 renovation of medical classroom to

 18 shall be expended by the department of education.

19 6. Waipahu high school

20 Construction for new portables to house
 21 department of education's adult



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1 education administrative offices to
 2 allow Waipahu high school students and
 3 staff to use existing space.

4 Construction \$3,000,000

5 Total funding \$3,000,000

6 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 7 shall be expended by the department of education.

8 7. Waipahu high school

9 Construction for phase 2 of campus
 10 painting.

11 Construction \$450,000

12 Total funding \$450,000

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 14 shall be expended by the department of education.

15 8. Waipahu high school

16 Construction for phase 2 of Waipahu
 17 high school's new integrated academic
 18 classroom building. This building will
 19 include eleven general classrooms.

20 Construction \$18,500,000

21 Total funding \$18,500,000



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 9. Waipahu high school

4 Design and construction for re-keying
 5 of all locks on exterior doors
 6 throughout campus.

7 Design \$50,000

8 Construction \$250,000

9 Total funding \$300,000

10 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 11 shall be expended by the department of education.

12 10. Waipahu intermediate school

13 Design and construction for completion
 14 of DREAMS building, ground and site
 15 improvements, and equipment and
 16 appurtenances.

17 Design \$350,000

18 Construction \$24,650,000

19 Total funding \$25,000,000

20 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 21 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 11. Leeward community college

2 Design and construction for fascia
3 repairs and replacement.

4 Design \$500,000

5 Construction \$5,000,000

6 Total funding \$5,500,000

7 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
8 shall be expended by the University of Hawaii.

9 12. Leeward community college

10 Design and construction for
11 modernization of automotive building to
12 ensure state-of-the-art facilities are
13 current with programmatic needs and
14 trends.

15 Design \$500,000

16 Construction \$3,500,000

17 Total funding \$4,000,000

18 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
19 shall be expended by the University of Hawaii.



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1 13. Leeward community college
 2 Design and construction for sidewalk
 3 repairs and replacement to address
 4 health and safety concerns and for
 5 Americans with Disabilities Act code
 6 and compliance requirements

7 Design \$400,000

8 Construction \$4,000,000

9 Total funding \$4,400,000

10 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 11 shall be expended by the University of Hawaii.

12 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 13 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 14 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 15 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
 16 of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
