
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-FOURTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$18,475,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 fourth representative district, as follows:

7 1. Highlands intermediate
8 Plans and construction for campus-wide
9 electrical upgrades to support air
10 conditioner installations.

12	Construction	\$3,000,000
13	Total funding	\$3,300,000

14 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
15 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 2. Pearl City high school
2 Design and construction for electrical
3 upgrades and updates to aging

5 their useful life.

18 6. Waiiau elementary

19 Design and construction for electrical
20 upgrades, including upgrades to the
21 transformer and switch gear and



1 increases to the electrical capacity
2 for the school.

3 Design \$100,000

4 Construction \$1,000,000

5 Total funding \$1,100,000

6 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
7 shall be expended by the department of education.

8 7. Waiiau elementary

9 Design and construction for replacement
10 of cafeteria floor.

11 Design \$25,000

12 Construction \$250,000

13 Total funding \$275,000

14 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
15 shall be expended by the department of education.

16 8. Waimalu elementary

17 Construction and equipment for re-
18 flooring building F (library).

19 Construction \$300,000

20 Equipment \$200,000

21 Total funding \$500,000

3 9. Waimalu elementary

4 Design, construction, and equipment for
5 heat abatement for buildings C, A, and
6 TB1-13.

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
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1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project

3 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
4 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
5 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
6 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
7 of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
