
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF
THE THIRTY-SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$32,421,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021
5 for the purposes of financing capital improvement projects for
6 the thirty-sixth representative district, as follows:

- 9 Plans, design, and construction to reroof campus

15 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
16 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation
17 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

18 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
19 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
