
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§328- Cannabidiol products; product testing. (a) All
5 products containing cannabidiol or marketed or sold as
6 containing cannabidiol shall only be sold in the State if:

7 (1) The product has a certificate of analysis prepared by
8 an independent testing laboratory that states the
9 product does not contain contaminants unsafe for human
10 consumption and contains a total delta-9-
11 tetrahydrocannabinol concentration that does not
12 exceed 0.3 per cent on a dry-weight basis pursuant to
13 the testing of a random sample of the batch; and

14 (2) The product is sold or distributed in packaging that
15 includes:



- 1 (A) A scannable barcode or quick reference code
- 2 linked to the certificate of analysis of the
- 3 product by an independent testing laboratory;
- 4 (B) The batch number;
- 5 (C) The internet address of a website where batch
- 6 information may be obtained;
- 7 (D) The expiration date;
- 8 (E) The number of milligrams of cannabidiol;
- 9 (F) A statement that the product contains a total
- 10 delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol concentration that
- 11 does not exceed 0.3 per cent on a dry-weight
- 12 basis; and
- 13 (G) A statement certifying that the product is free
- 14 from contaminants that are unsafe for human
- 15 consumption.
- 16 (b) For purposes of this section, "independent testing
- 17 laboratory" means a laboratory that:
- 18 (1) Does not have a direct or indirect interest in the
- 19 entity whose product is being tested;
- 20 (2) Does not have a direct or indirect interest in a
- 21 facility that cultivates, distributes, dispenses, or

Report Title:

Cannabidiol Products; Product Safety; Packaging Requirements

Description:

Requires all cannabidiol products sold in the State to be tested by an independent testing laboratory for contaminants unsafe for human consumption and THC levels. Requires the packaging on all cannabidiol products to contain information concerning THC levels and other product safety requirements.

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
