
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII BOARD OF REGENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-104, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3 "(c) At its first meeting after June 30 of each year, the
4 board of regents shall elect a chairperson and one or more vice-
5 chairpersons who shall serve until the adjournment of the first
6 meeting of the board of regents after June 30 of the next year,
7 or thereafter until their successors are elected; provided that
8 the chairperson and vice chairpersons shall not be elected prior
9 to the taking of office of regents whose terms shall begin on
10 July 1 of that year. The board shall appoint a secretary, who
11 shall not be a member of the board. The president of the
12 university shall act as executive officer of the board. A
13 majority of the board of regents shall constitute a quorum to
14 conduct business, and the concurrence of a majority of all the
15 members to which the board of regents is entitled shall be
16 necessary to make any action of the board of regents valid. The

- 1 (1) Meet at least ten times annually and, from time to
2 time, may meet in each of the counties of Hawaii,
3 Maui, and Kauai[-]; and
4 (2) Broadcast the meetings live on the Internet, record
5 the meetings in digital video format, and archive them
6 for public use within seventy-two hours after
7 adjournment of a meeting."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
