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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STADIUM AUTHORITY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 109-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:  
3           "(a) There shall be within the department of accounting  
4 and general services for administrative purposes only, a stadium  
5 authority whose responsibility shall be to maintain, operate,  
6 and manage the stadium and facilities attached thereto. The  
7 authority shall consist of [~~nine~~] eleven members who shall be  
8 appointed by the governor in the manner prescribed by section  
9 26-34.  
10           Of the eleven members, one member shall be a resident of  
11 one of the areas specified in paragraph (1), (2), or (3) and one  
12 member shall be a resident of the area specified in paragraph  
13 (4):  
14           (1) Excluding Ford Island, the area beginning at the  
15 intersection of Oahu shoreline and Admiral Carey (Ford  
16 Island) Bridge and running:



- 1           (A) Easterly along said bridge to Salt Lake  
2           boulevard;
- 3           (B) Southeasterly along said boulevard to H-1  
4           freeway;
- 5           (C) Southwesterly along said freeway to Luapele  
6           drive;
- 7           (D) Westerly along said drive to Fleet place;
- 8           (E) Southwesterly along said place to Ulithi street;
- 9           (F) Southwesterly along said street to unnamed road;
- 10          (G) Southwesterly along said road(s) to Luapele road;
- 11          (H) Westerly along said road to Ulihi road;
- 12          (I) Northwesterly along said road to Makalapa drive;
- 13          (J) Southwesterly along said drive to Ulihi road;
- 14          (K) Westerly along said road to Halawa drive;
- 15          (L) Northwesterly along said drive to Arizona street;
- 16          (M) Westerly along said street to Kamehameha highway;
- 17          (N) Northerly along said highway to Halawa stream;
- 18          (O) Westerly along said stream to Oahu shoreline; and
- 19          (P) Northerly along said shoreline to point of  
20          beginning;



- 1        (2) The area beginning at the intersection of Kaonohi  
2        street and H-1 freeway and running:
- 3        (A) Southeasterly along said freeway to Moanalua  
4        freeway - Kamehameha highway connector;
- 5        (B) Northwesterly along said highway connector to  
6        Kamehameha highway;
- 7        (C) Northwesterly along said highway to Aiea stream;
- 8        (D) Southerly along said stream to Oahu shoreline;
- 9        (E) Northwesterly along said shoreline to Kalauao  
10       stream;
- 11       (F) Northeasterly along said stream to Kamehameha  
12       highway;
- 13       (G) Northwesterly along said highway to Kaonohi  
14       street; and
- 15       (H) Northeasterly along said street to point of  
16       beginning; or
- 17       (3) The area beginning at the intersection of Waimalu  
18       stream and Koolau ridge and running:
- 19       (A) Southeasterly along said ridge to Ewa - Honolulu  
20       district boundary;



- 1           (B) Southwesterly along said boundary to Red Hill  
2           Naval Reservation boundary;
- 3           (C) Southwesterly along said boundary to Tampa drive;
- 4           (D) Westerly along said drive to unnamed road;
- 5           (E) Northerly along said road to Icarus way;
- 6           (F) Westerly along said way to unnamed road;
- 7           (G) Southwesterly along said road(s) to Moanalua  
8           freeway (H-201);
- 9           (H) Westerly along said freeway to H-1 freeway;
- 10          (I) Northwesterly along said freeway to Kaonohi  
11          street;
- 12          (J) Southwesterly along said street to Moanalua road;
- 13          (K) Westerly along said road to Kaahumanu street;
- 14          (L) Northerly along said street to Komo Mai drive;
- 15          (M) Easterly along said drive to Punanani gulch;
- 16          (N) Northeasterly along said gulch to powerline;
- 17          (O) Southeasterly along said powerline to Waimalu  
18          stream;
- 19          (P) Northeasterly along said stream to Aiea stream;
- 20          (Q) Easterly along said stream to Waimalu stream; and



- 1           (R) Southeasterly along said stream to point of  
2           beginning; or
- 3       (4) The area beginning at the intersection of H-1 freeway  
4       and Moanalua freeway (H-201) and running:
- 5           (A) Southeasterly along said freeway to Aliamanu  
6           Military Reservation boundary;
- 7           (B) Westerly along said boundary to Wanaka street;
- 8           (C) Southwesterly along said street to Likini street;
- 9           (D) Northwesterly along said street to Ukana street;
- 10          (E) Southwesterly along said street to Keaka drive;
- 11          (F) Northwesterly along said drive to Manuwa drive;
- 12          (G) Southeasterly along said drive to Pakini street;
- 13          (H) Southwesterly along said street to Keaka drive;
- 14          (I) Southerly along said drive to Puolo drive;
- 15          (J) Westerly along said drive to Likini street;
- 16          (K) Southerly along said street to Maluna street;
- 17          (L) Westerly along said street to Salt Lake  
18          boulevard;
- 19          (M) Southeasterly along said boulevard to unnamed  
20          feature;
- 21          (N) Southwesterly along said feature to Reeves loop;



- 1           (O) Southwesterly along said loop to Radford drive;  
2           (P) Westerly along said drive to Fuqua street;  
3           (Q) Northeasterly along said street to Radford drive;  
4           (R) Northwesterly along said drive to H-1 freeway;  
5           and  
6           (S) Northerly along said freeway to point of  
7           beginning.

8 Each member of the authority shall have been a citizen of the  
9 United States and a resident of the State for at least five  
10 years next preceding the member's appointment. The president of  
11 the University of Hawaii and the superintendent of education  
12 shall be ex officio members of the authority but shall not vote.

13           (b) The chairperson of the authority shall be elected by  
14 the majority of the authority. The term of each member shall be  
15 four years[~~r~~]; provided that [~~ef~~]:

16           (1) Of the members initially appointed three members shall  
17           serve for four years, three members shall serve for  
18           three years and the remaining three members shall  
19           serve for two years[~~r~~]; and

20           (2) The terms of the members added by Act \_\_\_\_\_, Session  
21           Laws of Hawaii 2020, shall commence July 1, 2020.



1 No person shall be appointed consecutively to more than two  
2 terms as a member of the authority. Vacancies shall be filled  
3 for the remainder of any unexpired term in the same manner as  
4 original appointments."

5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
