
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST
ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
3 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
4 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

5 SECTION 2. There are appropriated or authorized from the
6 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining
7 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 all
9 collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated
10 with the exclusive representative of collective bargaining unit
11 (9):

11 by chapter 89C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for state officers and
12 employees who are excluded from collective bargaining assigned
13 to the Hawaii health systems corporation and belong to the same
14 compensation plans as those officers and employees within
15 bargaining unit (9):

18 SECTION 13. Funds appropriated or authorized by this part
19 shall be allotted by the director of finance to the Hawaii
20 health systems corporation for expenditure in the respective
21 fiscal year for the purposes of this part.



1 PART VII

2 SECTION 14. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
3 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
4 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
5 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
6 from the respective funds.

7 SECTION 15. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
8 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2021, shall
9 lapse as of that date.

10 SECTION 16. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
