## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTY-FOURTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$20,025,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-  
6 fourth representative district, as follows:

7 1. Kaahumanu elementary school, Oahu  
8 Design and construction for ADA  
9 compliance of bathroom facilities.

11	Construction	\$155,000	
12	Total funding		\$215,000

13 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
14 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 2. Kaahumanu elementary school, Oahu  
2 Design and construction for replacement  
3 ceiling fans or air conditioning in the  
4 cafeteria.

5 Design \$15,000

6 Construction \$35,000

7 Total funding \$50,000

8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
9 shall be expended by the department of education.

10 3. Lincoln elementary school, Oahu

11 Plans, design, construction, and  
12 equipment for a covered play court.

13 Plans \$15,000

14 Design \$60,000

15 Construction \$390,000

16 Equipment \$35,000

17 Total funding \$500,000

18 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
19 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 4. Roosevelt high school, Oahu  
 2 Plans, design, construction, and  
 3 equipment for a new music and band  
 4 room.

6	Design	\$600,000
7	Construction	\$12,000,000
8	Equipment	\$500,000
9	Total funding	\$13,700,000

10 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 11 shall be expended by the department of education.

12 5. Stevenson middle school, Oahu  
 13 Construction and equipment for  
 14 installation of air conditioning in  
 15 twenty classrooms.

16	Construction	\$90,000
17	Equipment	\$150,000
18	Total funding	\$240,000

19 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 20 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 6. Washington middle school  
2 Plans, design, construction, and  
3 equipment for a modern coordinated  
4 performing arts academy, including a  
5 new band room, dance studio,  
6 auditorium, and parking structure, with  
7 upgrades to existing band, choir, and  
8 orchestra room.

9	Plans	\$800,000
10	Design	\$1,750,000
11	Construction	\$450,000
12	Equipment	\$100,000
13	Total funding	\$3,100,000

14 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
15 shall be expended by the department of education.

16 7. Halau Ku Mana public charter school,  
17 Oahu  
18 Plans, design, and construction for  
19 installation of a permanent learning  
20 pavilion to replace temporary  
21 structure.

 5 improvements.

6	Plans	\$10,000
7	Design	\$10,000
8	Construction	\$60,000
9	Total funding	\$80,000

10 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
 11 shall be expended by the state public charter school commission.

12 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
 13 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 14 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
 15 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
 16 of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
