
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-EIGHTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$25,169,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-
6 eighth representative district, as follows:

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

10 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 11 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 12 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 13 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
 14 of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
